PROVISION OF ON-STREET PARKING
FOR CAR CLUB VEHICLES

Leeds City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47 & 49 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and in pursuance of the powers contained in Section 73 and Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:

- 1 This Order is made on the 14th day of November 2008 and shall come into force on the 17th day of November 2008 and may be cited as "The Leeds City Council (Parking Places) (No.17) Order 2007"
- 2 For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a parking place shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one parking place where the context requires it
- 3 Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order
- 4 In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the following meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"a person authorised by the Council" means a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden

"Car Club" means a community car club or similar organisation (including any person or organisation acting on behalf of such club or organisation) approved in writing by the Council for the purposes of this Order

"Car Club parking place" means an area of a highway designated as a Car Club parking place by virtue of Article 5 of this Order

"Car Club vehicle" means a vehicle provided for the use of persons who have paid the relevant membership fee and by means of a real-time or advance booking system has access to the vehicle for a specified period and which displays the relevant identification

"driver" in relation to a vehicle left in a parking bay means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking bay

"parking bay" shall mean any area on a highway within a Car Club parking place designated by Article 5 and indicated on the carriageway of the highway in accordance with Article 9

"relevant identification" means a badge or other means of identification issued and/or approved by the Council indicating that the vehicle on which it is displayed is part of a fleet of vehicles owned and operated by a Car Club and valid for use in the Car Club parking place designated in this Order

- 5 The area of highway in Armley in the Metropolitan District of Leeds which is described as a parking place in Column 2 of the Schedule to this Order is hereby designated as a Car Club parking place
- 6 The Car Club parking place shall have within its length not more than the maximum number of parking bays specified in Column 3 of the Schedule to this Order
- 7 Subject to the said maximum number the number and disposition of such parking bays in the Car Club parking place shall be as determined from time to time by the Council
- 8 The Car Club parking place may be used subject to the provisions of this Order for the leaving of Car Club vehicles

"Car Club" means a community car club or similar organisation (including any person or organisation acting on behalf of such club or organisation) approved in writing by the Council for the purposes of this Order

"Car Club parking place" means an area of a highway designated as a Car Club parking place by virtue of Article 5 of this Order

"Car Club vehicle" means a vehicle provided for the use of persons who have paid the relevant membership fee and by means of a real-time or advance booking system has access to the vehicle for a specified period and which displays the relevant identification

"driver" in relation to a vehicle left in a parking bay means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking bay

"parking bay" shall mean any area on a highway within a Car Club parking place designated by Article 5 and indicated on the carriageway of the highway in accordance with Article 9

"relevant identification" means a badge or other means of identification issued and/or approved by the Council indicating that the vehicle on which it is displayed is part of a fleet of vehicles owned and operated by a Car Club and valid for use in the Car Club parking place designated in this Order


- 5 The area of highway in Armley in the Metropolitan District of Leeds which is described as a parking place in Column 2 of the Schedule to this Order is hereby designated as a Car Club parking place
- 6 The Car Club parking place shall have within its length not more than the maximum number of parking bays specified in Column 3 of the Schedule to this Order
- 7 Subject to the said maximum number the number and disposition of such parking bays in the Car Club parking place shall be as determined from time to time by the Council
- 8 The Car Club parking place may be used subject to the provisions of this Order for the leaving of Car Club vehicles

- 16.2 for the purpose of any building engineering or construction operation demolition or excavation adjacent to or in the parking bay
- 16.3 for the purpose of maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the parking bay or the laying erection alteration or repair in or near the parking bay or Car Club parking place of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 4(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1984 or of any traffic sign
- 16.4 for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking bay on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository
- 16.5 on any such occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed
- 16.6 for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking bay at times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions
- 17 A person authorised by the Council may suspend for not longer than twenty four hours the use of a parking bay whenever he/she considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety
- 18 A person authorised by the Council suspending the use of a parking bay in accordance with the provisions of Articles 16 and 17 of this Order shall thereupon place or cause to be placed upon the relevant part of the parking bay traffic cones (as described in the current Traffic Signs Regulations & General Directions) or such other traffic cones or lights as are appropriate to indicate that waiting by vehicles is prohibited
- 19 Subject to the proviso contained herein no person shall cause or permit any Car Club vehicle to be left in a parking bay during such period as there is a notice traffic cone sign or light placed within the parking bay in pursuance of Article 18 of this Order
- PROVIDED THAT** nothing in this paragraph shall apply to:

- 19.1 any vehicle being used for Fire Brigade Ambulance or Police purposes or any Local Authority purposes or for any purpose specified in Article 16.1
- 19.2 any other vehicle if that vehicle is so left with the permission of the person who authorised the suspension of use of the parking bay in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Article
- 20 Unless prior written consent has been granted by the Council no person shall:
 - 20.1 use a Car Club vehicle while it is in a parking bay in connection with the sale or advertisement of anything to persons in or near the parking bay or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services
 - 20.2 use any part of a parking bay with any building structure mechanical device or other physical feature therein or any Car Club vehicle left therein to display advertising material nor to place upon or attach to any Car Club vehicle in the parking bay any advertising material to induce the public to participate in or frequent any place function or gathering for the purpose of demonstration or entertainment or to buy or hire or otherwise obtain anything or the skill or services of any person and nothing shall be displayed to induce the public to engage for gain in any lottery sweepstake raffle or competition
- 21 Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Order with respect to Car Club vehicles which are left in a parking bay in accordance with those provisions any other vehicle may wait in a parking bay if:
 - 21.1 the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle
 - 21.2 the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident

- 21.3 the vehicle is a vehicle used for fire brigade purposes or an ambulance or a vehicle in the service of a Local Authority or a vehicle in the service of a police force in such cases being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
- 21.4 the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic
- 21.5 the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for any of the purposes specified in Article 16.2 to 16.6 and the use of the vehicle for any such purpose or the amount of time during which the vehicle will remain in the parking bay for that purpose does not in the opinion of the Council warrant the suspension of use of the parking bay
- 22 A person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in a parking bay by virtue of Article 21 shall take all necessary steps to ensure that the vehicle is left in accordance with Article 10
- 23 The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment
- 24 Where the provision of any Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 which imposes any prohibition or restriction on waiting by vehicles or grants any exemption from such prohibition or restriction relating to a length of road designated as a parking place in this Order the provisions of this Order shall prevail
