**18 TONNE WEIGHT LIMITS**

**STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER**

This order is proposed to bring existing restrictions up to date as the 17 tonne Weight Restrictions Orders which are currently in place are not permitted in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

Cemetery Road and Wesley Street in Beeston, the A58 in Wetherby and Monkswood and Scholes Lane Bridge, Scholes and Berry Lane Bridge, Great Preston all have 17 tonne orders which will be revoked and replaced with a single 18 tonne order for all six lengths.

The Order was originally advertised on 16 January 2009, but is now being re-advertised to include Scholes Lane Bridge and Berry Lane Bridge.

**18 TONNE WEIGHT LIMITS**

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight to proceed in the lengths of road specified in First Schedule to this Order
2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight other than a vehicle requiring access to or egress from land or buildings adjacent to the lengths of road to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Second Schedule to this Order
3. The Orders specified in Column 1 of the Third Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked to the extent specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the said Third Schedule

**18 TONNE WEIGHT LIMITS**

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to:-

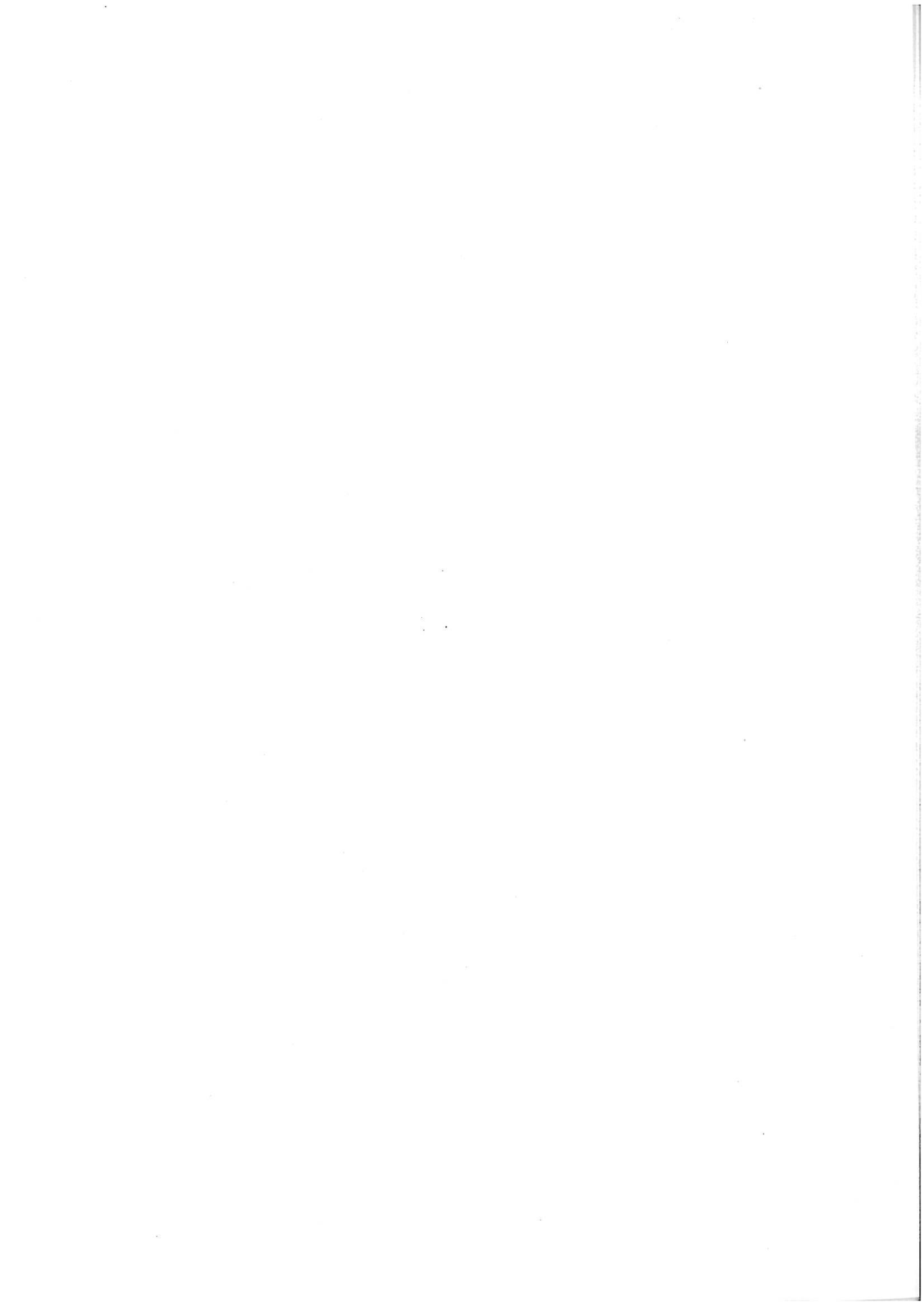
1. to prohibit vehicles exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight from proceeding in-
  - (i) the A58 Wetherby Road, Collingham (southbound only) from a point 30 metres east of its junction with Boston Road in a westerly and then south-westerly direction for a distance of 1975 metres;
  - (ii) Scholes Lane (Bridge), Scholes from its junction with the projected northern kerbline of Rakehill Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 50 metres;
  - (iii) Berry Lane (Bridge), Great Preston from a point 28 metres west of the projected western kerbline of the Station Road Industrial Estate Access Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres;
  
2. to prohibit vehicles exceeding 18 tonnes maximum gross weight (other than vehicles requiring access to or egress from land or buildings adjacent to the lengths of road) in:-
  - (i) Wesley Street, Beeston, Leeds from its junction with Elland Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Town Street, Beeston;
  - (ii) Cemetery Road, Beeston, Leeds from its junction with Elland Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Beeston Road;
  - (iii) the A58 Wetherby Road, Monkswood, Leeds from a point 33 metres south-west of the centre of the roundabout at its junction with the A6120 Ring Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 1133 metres.

Full details of the proposals in the form of a draft Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, St George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1, Beeston Library, Hugh Gaitskell School, St Anthony's Drive, Leeds 11, Scholes Library, 3 Station Road, Scholes, Allerton Bywater Library, The Old School, Vicars Terrace, Allerton Bywater and Wetherby Library, 17 Westgate, Wetherby.

**PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES EXCEEDING 18 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT.**

**Lengths of road in Moortown in the Metropolitan District of Leeds**

<b>NAME OF ROAD</b>	<b>EXTENT OF ORDER</b>
A58 WETHERBY ROAD COLLINGHAM (SOUTHBOUND ONLY)	From a point 30 metres east of the centre of the roundabout at its junction with Boston Road in a westerly and then south-westerly direction for a distance of 1975 metres.
SCHOLES LANE (BRIDGE) SCHOLES	From its junction with the projected northern kerblines of Rakehill Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 50 metres
BERRY LANE (BRIDGE) GREAT PRESTON	From a point 28 metres west of the projected western kerblines of the Station Road Industrial Estate Access Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres

**SECOND SCHEDULE**

**PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES EXCEEDING 18 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT (EXCEPT FOR ACCESS)**

**Lengths of road in Moortown in the Metropolitan District of Leeds**

WESLEY STREET BEESTON LEEDS	From its junction with Elland Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Town Street, Beeston.
CEMETERY ROAD BEESTON LEEDS	From its junction with Elland Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Beeston Road.
A58 WETHERBY ROAD MONKSWOOD LEEDS	From a point 33 metres south-west of the centre of the roundabout at its junction with the A6120 Ring Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 1133 metres.
