STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

In order to facilitate the movement of traffic during events in the locality and to assist with the dispersal of event goers by public transport Leeds City Council have decided to permit licensed Hackney Carriages to use the existing bus and cycle gateway from A643 to Elland Road in a north easterly direction only. In order to prevent confusion and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising this exemption will apply at all times.

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to amend the Fourth Schedule to the Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (No.33) Order 1994 to permit hackney carriages to make a right turn from the Ingram Road Distributor (north-east bound) into Elland Road (north-east bound)

Full details of the proposal in the form of a draft Order together with a plan showing the affected section of highway and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1.

AMENDMENT OF EXISTING ORDER

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. For the purposes of this Order "**hackney carriage**" has the same meaning as in Section 38 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 (for the avoidance of doubt this does not include a private hire vehicle within the meaning of Section 80 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976
2. The Order specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order is hereby amended to the extent specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the said Schedule
3. This Order is made on the day of 2009 and shall come into force on the day of 2009 and shall be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Movement Restrictions) (No.M14) Order 2009"
