**NO WAITING AT ANY TIME & NO WAITING 8.00AM – 8.00PM**

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to introduce:-

1. No waiting at any time restrictions on;
  - (a) The south side of Stainbeck Lane Chapel Allerton from a point 24 metres from its junction Wensley Drive for a distance of 30 metres in a easterly direction.
  - (b) Both sides of Henconner Lane from its junction with Stainbeck Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.
2. No waiting restrictions between 8.00 am and 8.00 pm on Monday to Saturday inclusive on;
  - (a) The north side of Stainbeck Lane from a point 40 metres from its junction with Harrogate Road for a distance of 11 metres in a westerly direction.
  - (b) The north side Stainbeck Lane from a point 85 metres from its junction with Harrogate Road for a distance of 35 metres in a westerly direction.
  - (c) The north side of Stainbeck Lane from its junction with Wensley Avenue for a distance of 50 metres in an easterly direction.
  - (d) The south side of Stainbeck Lane from its junction with Harrogate Road for a distance of 195 metres in a westerly direction

## WAITING RESTRICTIONS

- 2 Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order
- 3 Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 8.00 am and 8.00 pm on Monday to Saturday inclusive in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order
- 4 Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified therein so long as may be necessary:-
  - 4.1 to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle
  - 4.2 to enable a vehicle if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any wedding funeral building operation or demolition the removal of any obstruction in the length of road so specified or the laying erection alteration or repair in or near the said length of road of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in section 4(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1984
  - 4.3 to enable a vehicle to wait in the said lengths of road if it is a vehicle bearing a livery which is used by a universal service provider engaged in the collection and/or delivery of letters in accordance with statutory duties for the provision of services for the conveyance of letters

### REVOCATION

7. The Order specified in Column 1 of the Third Schedule to this Order is hereby amended/revoked to the extent specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the said Third Schedule

### GENERAL

8. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment
9. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road or a parking place shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road or parking place where the context requires it
