Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with the persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order is made on the *19* day of *March* 2010 and shall come into force on the *22* day of *March* 2010 and may be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Speed Limit) (No.2) Order 2010"
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order.

**40MPH SPEED LIMIT AND NO WAITING AT ANY TIME RESTRICTIONS**

Leeds City Council has today made the above Orders under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into operation on 22 March 2010 will be to introduce:-

1. a 40 miles per hour speed limit on Walton Road, Thorp Arch from a point 64.5 metres south of its junction with the unnamed access road to Thorp Arch Football Centre in a southerly direction for a distance of 535 metres; and
2. no waiting at any time on both sides of Walton Road, Thorp Arch from its junction with Grange Avenue for a distance of 564 metres in a southerly direction.

A copy of the Orders together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, St. George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and at Wetherby Library, 17 Westgate, Wetherby, LS22 6LL.

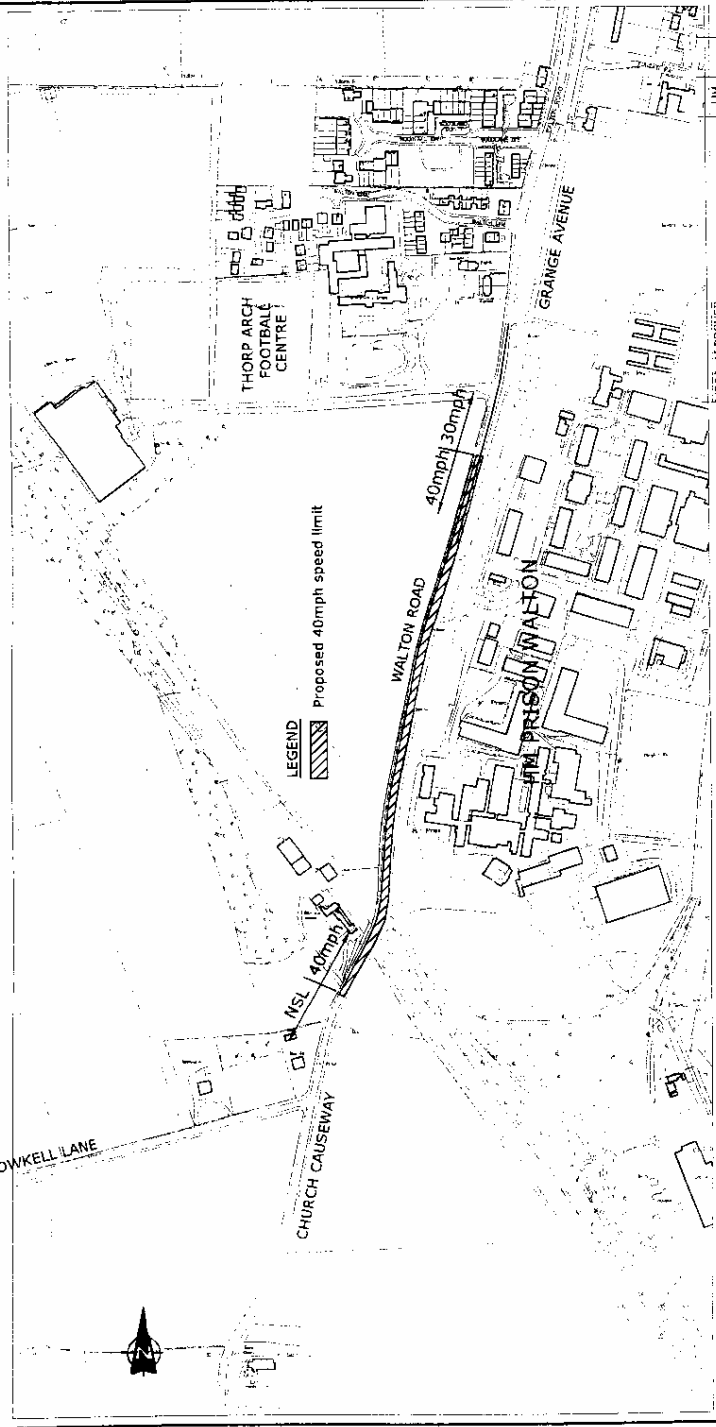
If you wish to object to question the validity of either Order or any provision contained within it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not be complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date upon which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
