

Leeds Civic Trust Blue Plaques for Chapeltown



Brandsby Lodge

A double fronted two storey classical house part of the New Leeds development and home to Alderman Sir Charles Wilson



Northern School of Contemporary Dance

The New Leeds Synagogue a large domed building with Art Deco and Byzantine influences



Leeds Media Centre

Typical Art Deco building which was originally the Jewish Institute and then the Leeds Trade Club



Newton Grove, Harehills Avenue

An impressive terrace of twelve Italianate three storey houses with a central villa



Newton Park Estate

A late 19thC exclusive residential development on the site of a nursery and tea gardens in the south part of the Lupton families estate, Newton Park



Jinnah Mosque, 21 Leopold St

An unassuming building with a rich history housing two synagogues and also the first mosque in Leeds



Hillcrest Primary School

The former Cowper Street School opened in 1905, it was the last to be built by the Leeds School Board and in scale, massing and decoration was the grandest



Gertrude Mareta Paul

When she got the Head Teacher's post at Elmhurst Middle School in 1976 she became the first black headmistress to be employed by Leeds Education Authority
