

A65 Kirkstall Road Quality Bus Initiative - Scheme Update 6 – August 2010

A65 QBI Traffic Management August 2010

August will see no change to the current traffic management on Commercial Road / Kirkstall Road between Beecroft Street and Burleywood Mount, approximately 800 metres (see Plan 1 Traffic Management - June 2010.pdf). The current arrangement of one lane in each direction will be maintained during all busy times and only slight delays are expected.

Gilbert Mount is planned to be closed from 06:00 on weekdays only, for the next two months (see Plan 3 Traffic Management - June 2010.pdf). During these times, local diversions will be in place.

The bus layby from Staples to Benfield Ford has been narrowed to one lane and pedestrians are being diverted safely into the carriageway. Therefore, from the 25th July 2010, a **no parking restriction** is in force in this area for approximately 9 weeks.

Night works

Overnight lane closures / temporary signals will continue throughout August across the site. We will be working from Sunday to Thursday nights every week between 19:00 hours and 06:00 hours. These works are undertaken overnight to minimise the impact of the works on road users.

Overnight on Saturday 4th September 2010 West Street is to be closed to allow the safe demolition of the sign gantry across West Street. The gantry spans the road between the Ibis Hotel and the entrance to West Street Car Park. The road closure will be in force from 20:00 hours Saturday 4th September until 10:00 hours on Sunday 5th September. Traffic diversions will be in place (see Plan 4 Traffic Management – September 2010.pdf & Plan 5 Traffic Management – September 2010.pdf).

The entrance to West Street Car Park will also be affected by the closure. The car park entrance will be closed from 20:00 hours Saturday 4th September until 12:00 hours on Sunday 5th September. The exit from the car park will remain open during the works to allow vehicles already parked in the car park, before the closure, to leave.

Further traffic management updates will be posted on this page as they become available. Dates given for closures are approximate and may be subject to change at short notice.
