

Partnership agreement between Leeds Library and Information Service and Voluntary Action-Leeds

Leeds Library and Information Service and Voluntary Action-Leeds (VA-L) have worked in partnership for some years, and both have been involved in collecting information to maintain databases of clubs and societies, voluntary organisations and community groups.

In recent years, this partnership has resulted in the Voluntary, Community and Faith Organisations in Leeds database (or “Volsec”) – a freely accessible database on the Library and Information Service’s website, that groups have been able to join and update as they wish.

The Volsec database has recently been developed and is now known as “Leeds Community Accesspoint”. VA-L will publicise Leeds Community Accesspoint to voluntary organisations in Leeds, and encourage groups to join and keep their details updated.

Leeds Library and Information Service and VA-L will continue to discuss the most appropriate methods of making the information they hold on voluntary organisations in Leeds freely available.
