

**LEEDS CITY COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS)
(No.W9) ORDER 2011 - LEEDS WEST ACADEMY BRAMLEY
(No.W11) ORDER 2011 - FARNLEY PARK SCHOOL CHAPEL LANE FARNLEY
(No.W13) ORDER 2011 - BISMARCK DRIVE HUNSLET**

Leeds City Council has today made the above Orders under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into force on 5 December 2011 is to introduce:-

No waiting at any time on sections of

1. Leeds West Academy Bramley Access Road 1 off Calverley Lane (east side - full length and west side).
2. Leeds West Academy Bramley Access Road 2 off Summerfield Drive (both sides).
3. Calverley Lane Bramley (south side).
4. Intake Lane Bramley (east side).
5. Summerfield Drive Bramley (north side).
6. Bismarck Drive Hunslet (north-western and south-eastern sides).
7. Disraeli Gardens Hunslet (south-eastern side).

No stopping on School Entrance Markings on

1. Intake Lane Bramley (east side) from 8:00am to 9.00am and 2.00pm to 4.00pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive.
2. Bismarck Drive Hunslet (south east side) from 8:30am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 3.30pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive.
3. Chapel Lane Farnley (east side) from 8:00am to 4:00pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

A copy of each Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal Services, 1st Floor, St. George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1.

If you wish to object to question the validity of any Order or any provision contained within it on the ground that is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not be complied with in relation to any Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date upon which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THIS ORDER

Leeds West Academy originally Intake High School is currently being constructed on the site of Intake High School. The highway works required in relation to these works include the widening of the existing footway on Intake Lane adjacent to the school entrance, a bus lay-by on Calverley Lane and an informal crossing point adjacent to the access road off Summerfield Drive.

In order to prevent danger to persons, to facilitate the passage on the road and for improving the amenities of the area near the School, it is proposed to make a traffic regulation Order to introduce;

- i) No waiting at any time on a sections of Calverley Lane, Summerfield Drive and Intake Lane and the two access roads to the Academy; and
- ii) No stopping on school entrance markings between the hours of 8.00am and 9.00am and between 2.00pm and 4.00pm Monday to Fridays inclusive on a section of Intake Lane.

Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and in pursuance of the powers contained in Section 73 and Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

DEFINITIONS

1. For the purposes of this Order:-

"civil enforcement officer"

means a person authorised by the Council for the enforcement of road traffic contraventions.

2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer cause or permit any vehicle to stop wait or otherwise leave the vehicle in a stationary manner between the hours of 8:00AM and 4:00PM on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order

GENERAL

3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment
4. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road or a parking place shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road or parking place where the context requires it
5. This Order is made on the 2 day of December 2011 and shall come into effect on the 5 day of December 2011 and may be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Waiting Restrictions) (No.W11) Order 2011
