Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to:-

1. Introduce no waiting loading or unloading from 8:00am to 9:00am and from 3:00pm to 6:00pm Monday to Friday inclusive on the north-east side of Austhorpe Lane a point 34 metres south of Whitkirk Close in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 58 metres and from its junction with Barrowby Lane for a distance of 17 metres in a north-westerly direction and also from its junction with Austhorpe Lane for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Introduce no stopping on school entrance markings from 8:00am to 9:00am and from 3:00pm to 6:00pm Monday to Friday inclusive on the north-east side of Austhorpe Lane from a point 92 metres south of Whitkirk Close in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 64 metres.

A copy of the Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St George House, Great George Street Leeds 1 and at Cross Gates Library, Farm Road, Leeds LS15 7LB.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or an instrument made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the date upon which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Concerns have been raised with the Highway Authority regarding inconsiderate parking outside Austhorpe Primary School, Austhorpe Lane for the purpose of dropping off and picking up children. The consequence of this parking is to block the entrance and exit to the staff car park at the start and finish of the school day and also later in the evening when up children are collected from after school activities.

Advisory 'Keep Clear' markings already exist outside the school but despite efforts to educate drivers about the problems caused, inconsiderate parking still occurs.

The parking of vehicles also takes place on Austhorpe Lane at its the junction with Barrowby Lane, which may potentially cause a danger to other vehicles and to pedestrians attempting to cross this road.

It is, therefore, proposed to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order preventing vehicles from stopping on school entranced markings on Austhorpe Lane, Monday to Friday inclusive, between the hours of 8:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 6:00pm. It is also proposed to introduce a single yellow line either side of the school keep clear markings to prevent vehicles from waiting, loading or unloading during the same time periods.

These restrictions will help avoiding danger to persons or traffic by allowing a better sight line for persons and vehicles entering and exiting the school. They will also help to facilitate the improved passage of traffic.

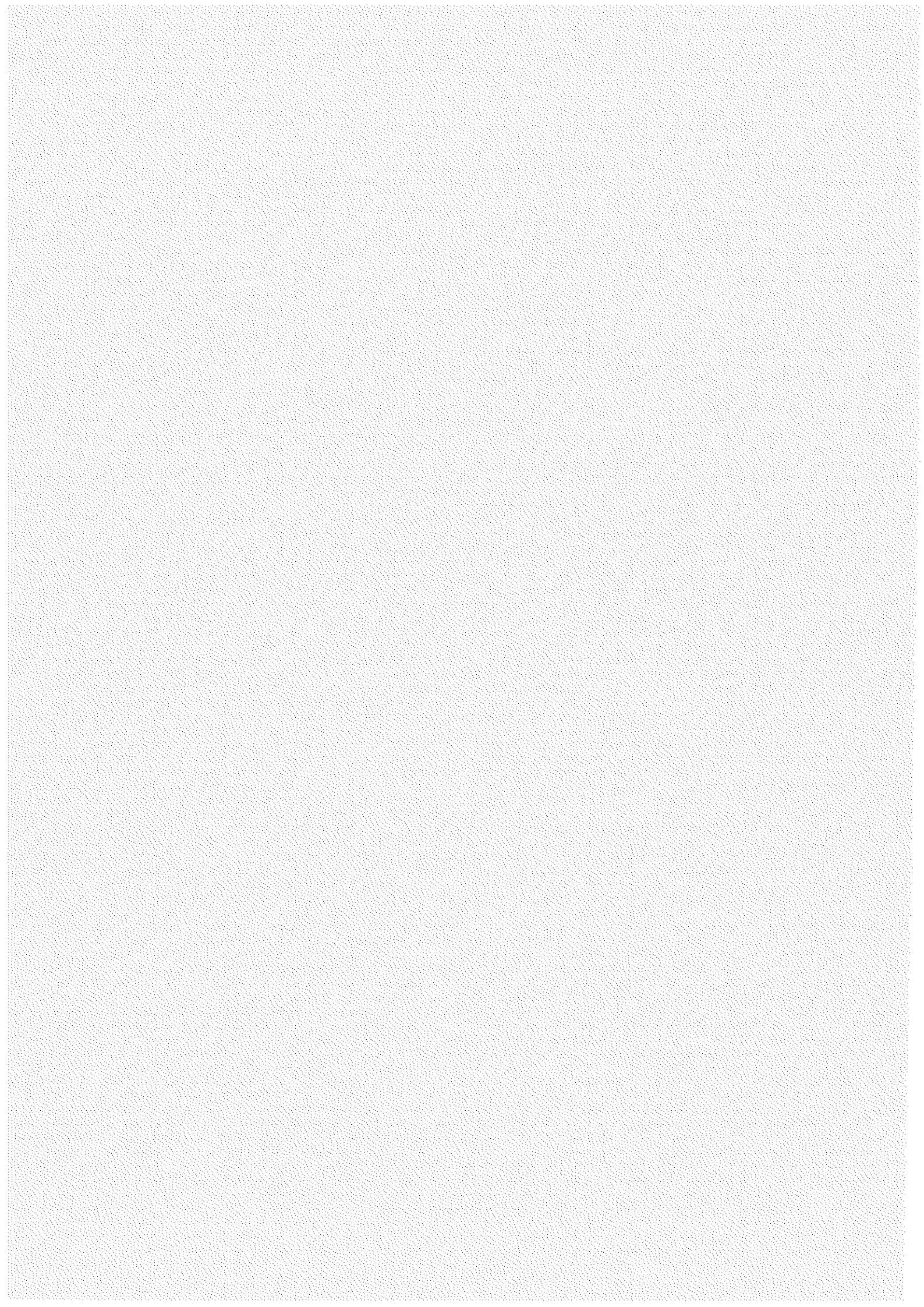

Leeds City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers contained in Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and in pursuance of the powers contained in Section 73 and Schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers so enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order

DEFINITIONS

1. **For the purposes of this Order:**

| "Relevant Position" | has the same meaning as given in Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 |
| "Universal Service provider" | has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000 |

WAITING RESTRICTIONS

- 2 Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait load or unload in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order between the hours of 8:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 6:00pm Monday to Friday inclusive
- 3 Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified therein so long as may be necessary:-
 - 3.1 to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle
 - 3.2 to enable a vehicle if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any wedding funeral building operation or demolition the removal of any obstruction in the length of road so specified or the laying erection alteration or repair in or near the said length of road of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in section 4(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1984
 - 3.3 to enable a vehicle to wait in the said lengths of road if it is a vehicle bearing a livery which is used by a universal service provider engaged in the collection and/or delivery of letters in accordance with statutory duties for the provision of services for the conveyance of letters
 - 3.4 to enable a vehicle to be used in the said lengths of road for police ambulance fire brigade local authority sewerage or water undertakers purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
 - 3.5 if a vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or for such waiting as is necessary to prevent an accident

- 3.6 for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while it is in actual use in connection with the delivery or removal of furniture to or from any premises fronting on to the said lengths of road **PROVIDED THAT** notice is given 24 hours in advance to the police and their consent obtained

NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS


4. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to stop wait or otherwise leave the vehicle in a stationary manner between 8:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 6.00pm Monday to Friday inclusive in the length of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order

GENERAL

5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment
6. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road or a parking place shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road or parking place where the context requires it
7. This Order is made on the 4 day of February 2011 and shall come into effect on the 7 day of February 2011 and may be cited as the "Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (Waiting Restrictions) (No.W31) Order 2010

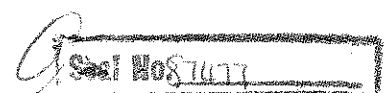
